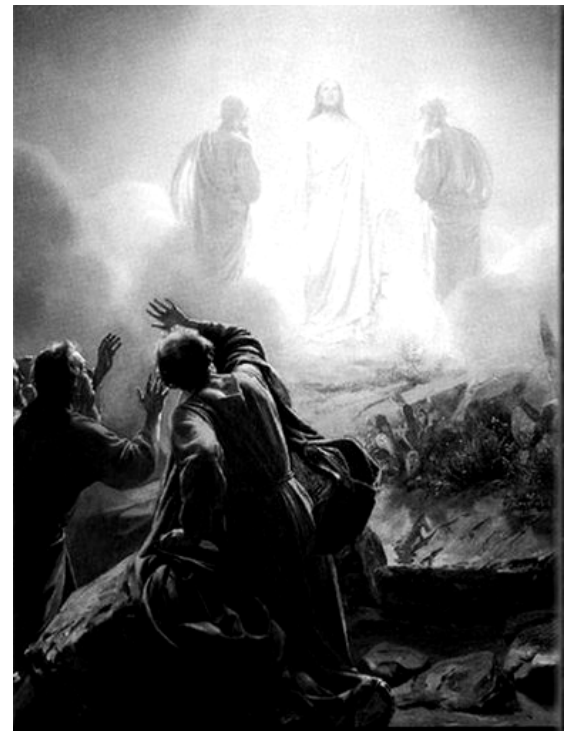

Luke 9:28-36

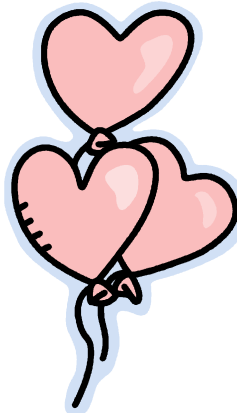
Worship Notes
